## ABOUT THE LIBRARY

---

The George W. Bush Presidential Library, the nation's thirteenth presidential library, is administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). It is temporarily located in Lewisville, Texas. The permanent Presidential Center will be located on the campus of Southern Methodist University (SMU) in Dallas, Texas.

The George W. Bush Library holds millions of pages of official records documenting the two-term administration (2001-2009) of the nation's forty-third president. In addition to these textual records, the Library will also receive millions of electronic records through NARA's Electronic Record Archives (ERA). The George W. Bush Library also has an extensive audiovisual collection containing photographs and videotapes, as well as an extensive artifact collection containing presidential domestic and foreign gifts.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

---

**When will the George W. Bush official records be available for research?**

The George W. Bush Presidential records are governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA). Under the provisions of the PRA, George W. Bush Presidential records are not available to public access requests for the first five years after the end of the Administration. George W. Bush Presidential records will become subject to Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests on January 20, 2014.
