John G. Roberts, Nominee for D.C. Circuit

- John Roberts, 46, is a nationally respected Supreme Court advocate and appellate lawyer. President George H.W. Bush nominated Roberts to the D.C. Circuit in 1992, but the congressional session expired before the Senate considered Roberts' nomination.
- In light of Roberts' extensive background in private practice and public service, and his demonstrated legal talent and intellect, Roberts is superbly qualified to be a judge on the D.C. Circuit.
- Roberts is currently a partner at Hogan & Hartson in Washington, D.C., where he is head of the firm's appellate practice group. He has been at Hogan since 1993, and he also was at that firm from 1986 to 1989.
- Roberts was Principal Deputy Solicitor General of the United States from 1989 to 1993.
- In private practice and in the Solicitor General's office, Roberts has argued 17 cases before the Supreme Court of the United States. He has argued ___ cases before United States Courts of Appeals around the country and ___ cases before state appellate cases.
- Roberts served as Associate Counsel to President Reagan from 1982 to 1986.
- Roberts was Special Assistant to Attorney General William French Smith from 1981 to 1982.
- Roberts was a law clerk to then-Associate Justice William H. Rehnquist on the Supreme Court of the United States in 1980-81.
- Roberts was a law clerk to Judge Henry Friendly on the U.S. Court of Appeals for Second Circuit in 1979-1980.
- Roberts graduated from Harvard Law School *magna cum laude* in 1979. He was managing editor of the *Harvard Law Review*.
- Roberts graduated from Harvard College *summa cum laude* in 1976.
- Roberts and his wife have two daughters.
