Thank you for providing me with the cases, Brett. I have been reading them. I

am on my way back to Washington after participating in a conference on the future of presidential libraries held at the Johnson Library.

What I have tried to do for the meeting is get together people who represent organizations with a special interest in presidential records. I am a presidency scholar and serve as the representative to the National Archives for the American Political Science Association. It is just something I do on an unpaid basis in addition to teaching at Towson University and running the White House 2001 Project, which includes the White House Interview Program. Robert Jervis - past President of the American Political Science Association and teaches at Columbia University Robert Spitzer - Presidency Research Group, a section of APSA, and teaches in the SUNY system Terry Sullivan - the James Baker Institute. Terry talked to Judge Gonzales when the Counsel spoke a couple of months ago at Rice University. He too is a presidency scholar and is the Associate Director of the White House 2001 Project. Teaches at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Bruce Craig - National Coordinating Committee for the Promotion of History - it is an umbrella organization for around two dozen groups representing mostly historians, political scientists, and archivists Steve Hensen - President, Society of American Archivists and teaches at Duke University. Arnita Jones - Executive Director of the American Historical Association Scott Nelson - a lawyer with Public Citizen who worked on records issues on behalf of former President Nixon A representative for the Organization of American Historians and the American Society of Newspaper Editors. I will ask for their birth dates and Social Security numbers and provide them to your office.
