ADMINISTRATIVE ALERT

Pageant of Peace Tree Lighting Ceremony -- Alternate Parking

The annual Pageant of Peace Tree Lighting Ceremony is scheduled for Thursday, December 6, 2001, with events to be held on the Ellipse. On this day, there will be no parking on the east side of the Ellipse. Valid Ellipse permit holders may enter the area until 3:00PM. After 3:00PM, there will be no entrance to or exit from the Ellipse until 6:30PM. If you arrive after 3:00PM, or anticipate the need to move your vehicle before 6:30PM please note permit holders may park in the following

alternate locations:

1. Washington Monument Oval Lot, which should be accessed from the south side of Constitution Avenue at 16th Street. There are few spaces available in this lot.

2. The limited alternate parking areas provided by the District of Columbia Department of Public Works, which include:

- ú east side of 14th Street between Independence and Constitution Avenues;
- ú north side of Pennsylvania Avenue between 6th and 13th Streets;
- and
- ú south side of Pennsylvania Avenue between 6th and 12th Streets.

These areas have been designated "emergency no parking" areas so that you may park there on Thursday between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Also, the District has informed us that, on Thursday only, you may disregard the rush hour parking restrictions for these designated areas. Please refrain from parking in handicap spaces, bus zones or crosswalks or in front of fire hydrants to avoid the risk of receiving a parking citation or having your car towed.

Please note that the alternate parking is extremely limited and only available on a first come, first served basis. You are strongly encouraged to utilize public transportation to avoid traffic jams and limited parking.
