Dear Mrs. Burnett:

I write in response to your August 29 letter to the President inquiring about your ability to file a lawsuit without compromising your ability to accept the government compensation fund.

As the Department of Justice has now made clear, you may file a lawsuit without affecting your ability to participate in the government compensation fund. If you file a claim under the fund, you may file a lawsuit for collateral source obligations or against someone who "is a knowing participant in any conspiracy to hijack any aircraft or commit any terrorist act." If you file a claim with the fund and file a lawsuit that is not a suit to recover collateral source obligations and is not a suit against someone who is not a "knowing participant in any conspiracy to hijack any aircraft or commit any terrorist act," you are still eligible for compensation from the fund. In that situation, your lawsuit would be dismissed, but your participation in the fund would be unaffected. This rule applies regardless whether you file your claim with the fund before or after filing a lawsuit.
