I crunched a few numbers on cloture votes on judicial nominees. These calculations do not include freshmen. If voting against cloture is a sign of obstruction, there's no comparison.

35 Senators have NEVER voted against cloture:
91.4% (32) are Republicans, 8.6% (3) are Democrats

76.1% (32/42) of Republicans NEVER voted against cloture
6.25% (3/48) of Democrats NEVER voted against cloture

55 Senators have voted against cloture:
81.8% (45) are Democrats, 18.2% (10) are Republicans

23.9% (10/42) of Republicans have voted against cloture
93.75% (45/48) of Democrats have voted against cloture
