#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2014-0334-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2014-0334-F contains records created by or sent to Robert Hoyt, General Counsel of the US Department of the Treasury, on issues relating to securities regulation, market regulation, and the Securities and Exchange Commission.

This FOIA primarily contains electronic records which consist of emails, news clips, and text of House and Senate bills regarding securities and market regulations. Textual records include

vetting forms, a resume, and an internet printout regarding the appointment of Robert Hoyt to General Counsel of the Department of the Treasury.

# System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2014-0334-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files and George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
