Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2014-0570-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2014-0570-F requested materials related to Russian President Vladimir Putin's visit to Crawford in November 2001.

This FOIA primarily contains cover sheets, routing memoranda, talking points, the Daily Diary, fact sheets, correspondence, press releases, transcripts, internet printouts, printed emails, seating charts, draft and final menus, joint statements and finalized drafts thereof, routine planning documents, routine briefings, and draft and final schedules for President George W. Bush, Vice President Richard B. Cheney, Mrs. Laura Bush, and Mrs. Lyudmila Putina. Topics of the Joint

Statements include Afghanistan, the Middle East, and Cooperation Against Bioterrorism. Correspondence includes a routine and unclassified cable from President George W. Bush to President Vladimir Putin, a routine and unclassified memorandum of conversation between President George W. Bush and President Vladimir Putin, letters to and from Congress, letters relating to the economic cooperation of a Russian and American city, a letter from Senator Ted Kennedy thanking President George W. Bush for an event honoring the late Robert Kennedy, and a letter thanking President George W. Bush for an invitation to dinner with President Vladimir Putin. Planning documents for the state visit include handwritten notes, printed emails, and related material discussing the schedule of events, menus, event attendees, travel arrangements, and the press situation for the events held at Prairie Chapel Ranch.

Electronic records consist of pool reports, press gaggles, press briefings, press releases, remarks, articles, scheduling materials, logistical information regarding the trip to Prairie Chapel Ranch, translation and interpretation information and feedback, the menu for the dinner at Prairie Chapel Ranch with President Vladimir Putin, and photos of the visit.

It should be noted that many of the documents in this FOIA have been closed due to National Security classification and/or exemptions of the Freedom of Information Act.

Please note that a portion of classified records related to this request has not yet been processed. Additional records will be provided as they become available.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2014-0570-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files, Staff Member Office Files, and George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at www.georgewbushlibrary.smu.edu

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
