FOIA 2015-0295-F requested materials related to a ceremony unveiling a new U.S. Postal Service stamp commemorating the efforts of recovery workers in the aftermath of the September 11th terrorist attack on the World Trade Center in New York City.

This FOIA primarily contains photographs of the Oval Office ceremony from March 11, 2002, including greeting participants, unveiling the stamp, and group photos of President George W. Bush with Postmaster General Jack Potter, Firefighter Bill Eisengrein, Firefighter George

Johnson, Congressman Gary Ackerman, Firefighter Dan Williams and Photographer Thomas E. Franklin.
