Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2016-0366-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-0366-F requested materials related to all unclassified textual records relating to the Heavily Indebted Poor Countries Initiative.

This FOIA primarily contains schedules, routine memoranda, White House staffing memoranda, routine correspondence, printed emails, descriptions of locations where meetings were held, webpages, printed articles, data sheets, unsolicited resumes, resumes of selected individuals, White House Communication publications, congratulatory correspondence from Heads of State, gift register forms, invitations, and charts.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2016-0366-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files and Staff Member Office Files.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject Files and Alpha Files were compiled by staff in the White House Office of Records Management and are a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a series of categories by subject. WHORM Subject Files and WHORM Alpha Files are processed at the document level.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
