**Abstract:** Anna Lisa Holand served as a Special Assistant to the President in the Domestic Policy Council from March 2005 to March 2006. This collection primarily contains briefing papers, memos, and scheduling requests for events that related to domestic policy topics such as immigration, education, health, and the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina.
