FOIA 2016-0177-F requested textual materials related to correspondence between Condoleezza Rice and experts on Russia including Thomas Graham, Michael McFaul, Coit "Chip" Blacker, Stephen Cohen, James Goldgeier, Fiona Hill, Stephen Kotkin, Andrew Kuchins, Kimberly Marten (previously Marten-Zisk), Steven Sestanovich, Angela Stent, Kathryn Stoner (previously Stoner-Weiss), and Celeste Wallander.

This FOIA primarily contains a barcode scanning sheet, final and draft letters from President George W. Bush to Reverend Keith Roderick, event participation forms, internet printouts, a

briefing paper for an event on Darfur, and letters to President George W. Bush and Condoleezza Rice concerning Darfur from multiple people, including Michael McFaul.

Please note that a portion of classified records related to this request has not yet been processed. Additional records will be provided as they become available.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2016-0177-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.
