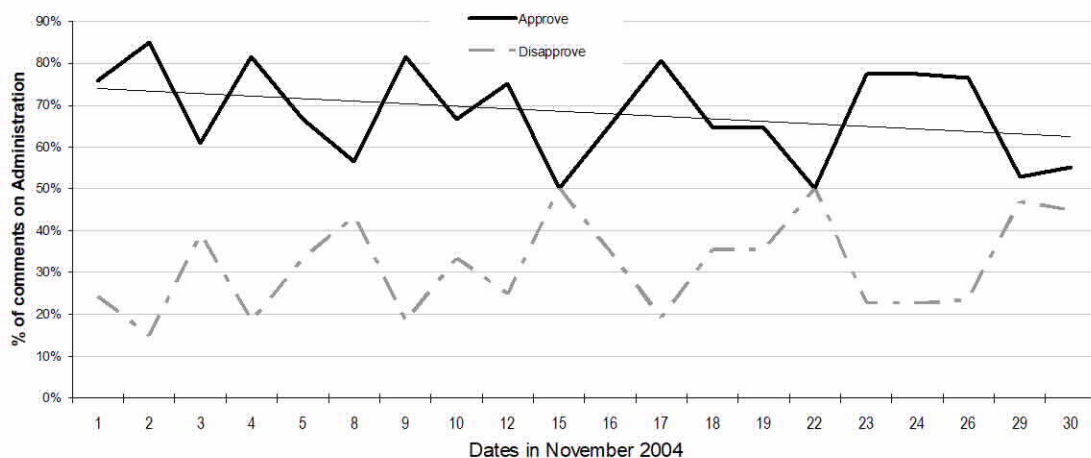

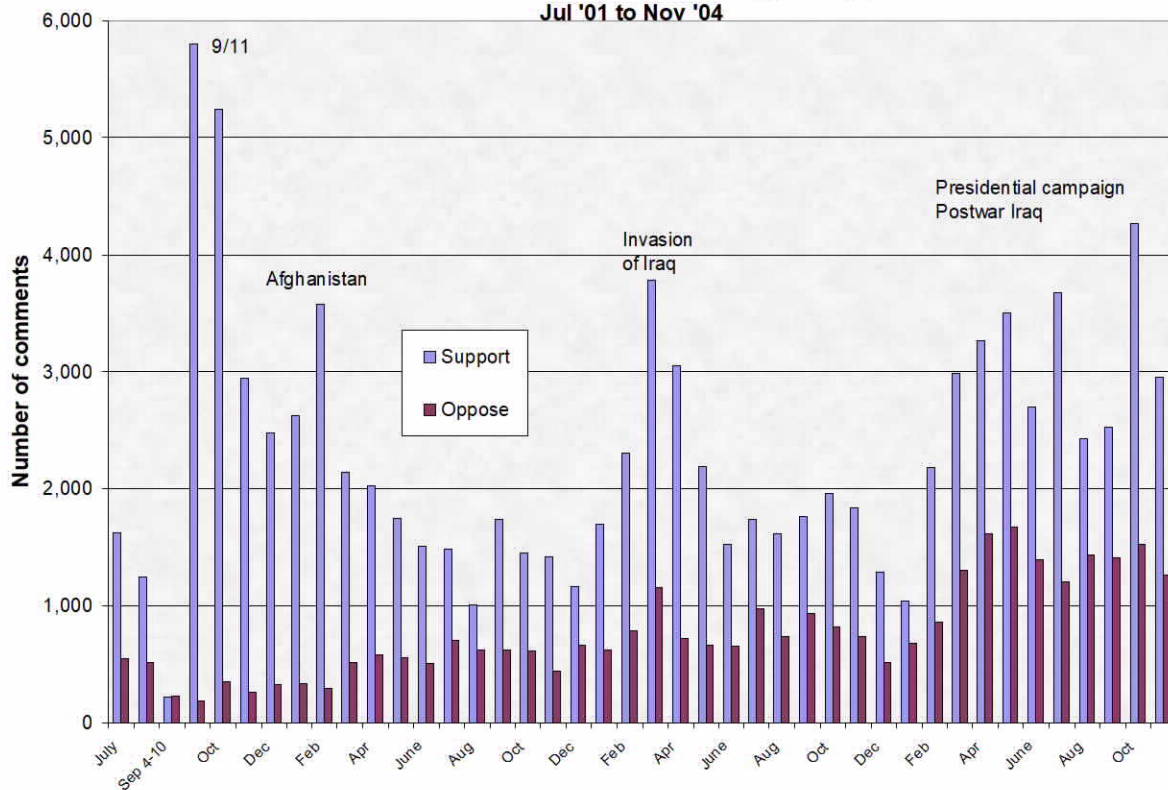

Bush administration overall approval at 70%

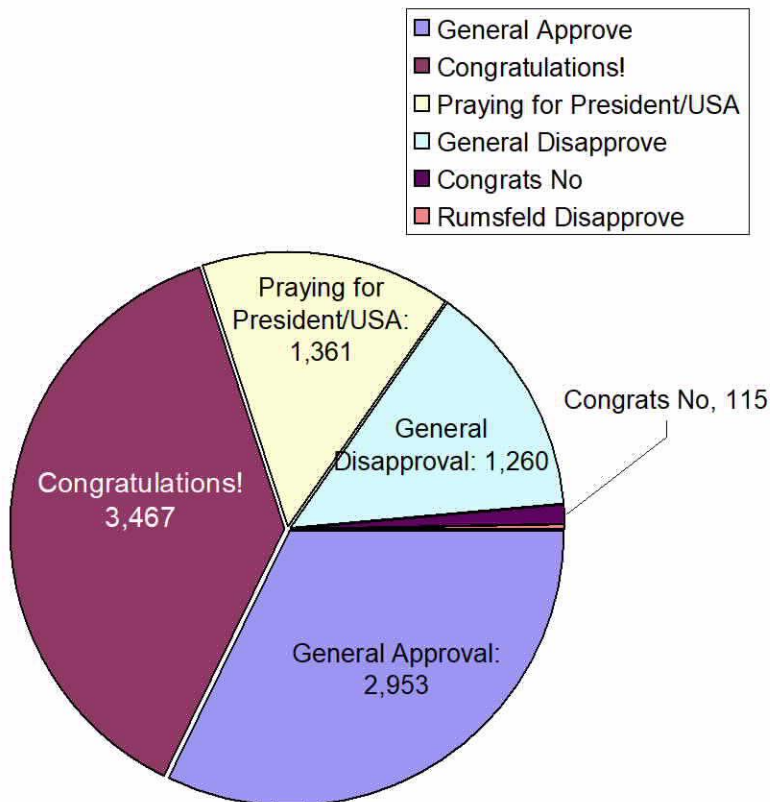
Bush Administration Overall Performance %

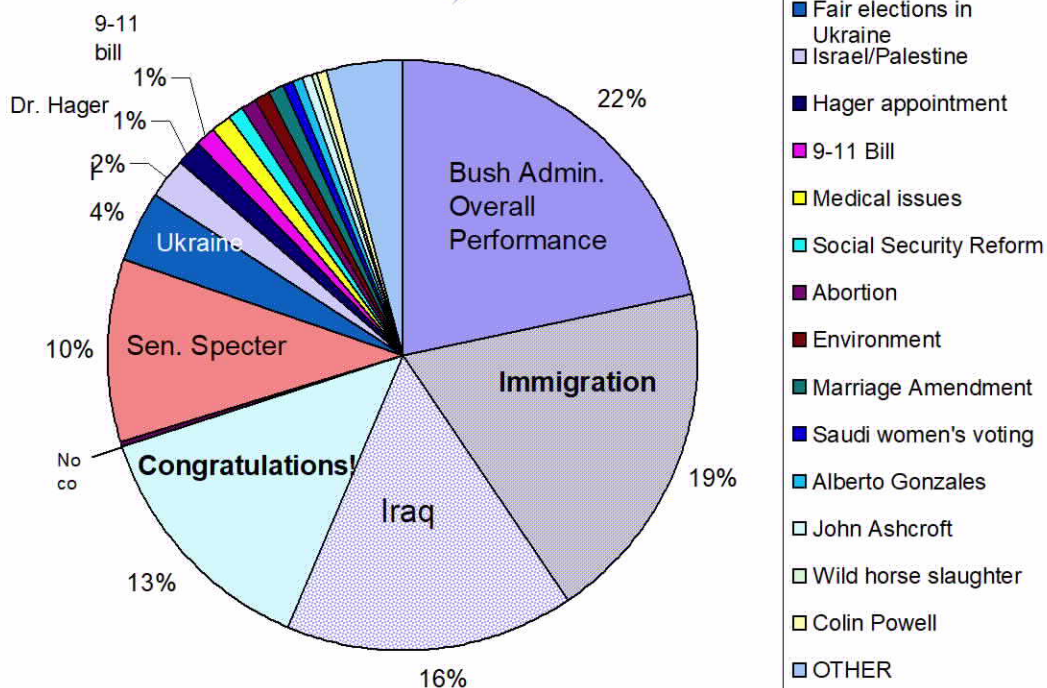

Senator Specter: 2,560 total comments

-2,560 callers regarding Senator Specter's involvement on the Judiciary Committee, 99% strongly disapprove. The vast majority of these callers indicate that they believe Senator Specter will not support Pro-Life judges.

U.S. action in Iraq: 4,080 total comments

Summary of approval comments(2,359 total): 1,691 urge the administration to support the **Marine** charged with the shooting of the enemy. 398 comments support the increased intensity of fighting in Fallujah. 270 comments overall approval of U.S. action in Iraq.

Summary of disapproval comments(1,721 total): 715 comments overall disapproval of U.S. action. 444 comments want U.S. troops to return home a.s.a.p. 277 comments disapprove increased intensity of fighting in Fallujah. 235 comments disapprove a "backdoor draft." 50 comments urge the administration to support the domestic economy, not Iraq's.

Ukraine elections: 1,025 total comments

1,025 comments regarding recent Presidential election in Ukraine, 99% believe the first election was fraudulent and urge the administration to encourage a fair election. The vast majority of these callers also indicate support for Mr. Yushchenko.
