Official records of George W. Bush's presidency are housed at the George W. Bush Presidential Library and are administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2023-0016-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2023-0016-F requested electronic materials related to the Second Chance Act from January 2003 through June 2003.

This FOIA primarily contains draft memorandums about prisoners and prison reform; draft memorandums, timelines, and narratives about crime and second amendment legacy; draft copies of accomplishments to include in the President's book *A Charge Kept: The Bush Record 2001-2008*; draft fact sheets and reports created by the Office of Faith Based and Community Initiatives, such as "Improving Prisoner Reentry Services Through Faith and Community-Based

Partnership;” a draft report on National Drug Control Strategy; speech drafts, including the State of the Union; night notes regarding the status of various congressional bills; and some emails related to administrative or routine office functions. These materials are from the CEA Shared Drive, NSC Shared Drive, OA Shared Drive, ODP Shared Drive and the RNC Personal Storage Table (PST) Search and Access Sets. It should be noted that the requester narrowed the topic to exclude the shared drives; however, the electronic records from the shared drives listed were inadvertently included and processed with the exception of the WHO Shared Drive.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2023-0016-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House’s electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.

The following is a list of electronic search results lists (SRLs) processed in response to FOIA 2023-0016-F:

George W. Bush Electronic Records

CEA contains 9 assets, all of which are released in full.

NSC contains 12 assets, of which 11 are released in full, and 1 is withheld in full.

OA contains 39 assets, all of which are released in full.

ODP contains 125 assets, of which 121 are released in full, 3 are withheld in part, and 1 is withheld in full.

RNCPST contains 1 asset, which is released in full.
