Provenance

Official records of George W. Bush's presidency are housed at the George W. Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2016-0105-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-0105-F requested materials related to education speeches and events on January 8-9, 2002, including the bill signing for the No Child Left Behind Act.

The textual records from this FOIA primarily contain schedules, briefing papers, speech drafts, talking points, Q&As, fact sheets, printed emails, news articles, budget documents, correspondence, barcode scanning sheets, fax cover sheets, and routing memos. Also included are draft and final thank you letters from President Bush to event participants, administrative

emails and spreadsheets relating to the attendance of Congressmen and other VIPs at events, and background information on the event sites.

The electronic records from this FOIA primarily consist of speech drafts, emails containing schedules for upcoming presidential events, routine emails with attached speech drafts, emails regarding administrative details related to the bill signing, emails between White House staff and reporters wishing to gain access to presidential events or request interviews, and a list of the schools visited by President Bush.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2016-0105-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files, Staff Member and Office Files, and George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Subject Files compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at www.georgewbushlibrary.smu.edu

Staff Member and Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
