Also, to thank you for considering a celebration of Decpavali (fondly called Diwali) at The White House. The ceremony can be designed to suit your schedule. Usually, it takes about an hour. We can work out the details, with your staff, to be presented to you for your approval. Diwali falls this year on October 25 and it does not need to be celebrated at The White House on that day. Any time within the next 15 days would carry the same sentiment. An appropriate Proclamation or a Message of Greetings from you on this holy occasion would be greatly appreciated by the Indian community worldwide.

Mr. President, your Administration has already made an impact as far as "inclusiveness" is concerned. Celebration of Diwali at The White House will be another landmark in your philosophy of inclusiveness and more than a billion Hindus worldwide would be grateful to you and the USA for this inclusiveness.

And just one more suggestion: Sir, I believe your mentioning during your meeting with India's Prime Minister Honorable Vajpai a possibility of a Diwali celebration at The White House would go a long way in further strengthening ties between India and USA.

Dear Mr. Rove:

You've been uppermost in my thoughts lately.

For there's nobody, out of the thousands who have helped me, that I would rather confide in than you on the issue of one particular tax, so I'm going to divulge a plan I've devised that I know will drive the final nail in the coffin of the much-despised "death tax."

I'm not exaggerating and I'm not making a pie-in-the-sky promise. I'd like to hear from you because I'd like your opinion. Once you've read this letter through, please call me. I know it will work, but if you can punch holes in my plan, I'd like to know that, too.

My office phone is (703) 807-2070. My cell is (b)(6) (b)(6) and my home is (b)(6) in Arlington, VA. If I am not readily available, my wife, Mary Lou, will know how to reach me.

My game plan will abolish, once and for all, the so-called "death tax," the hated estate tax that has plagued entrepreneurs since 1916. While Congress has voted to phase it out over 10 years, I believe we can get it repealed immediately.

Mr. Rove, I'm so excited about what is a fairly simple solution to this long-time problem that I hardly know where to begin this very personal note to you.

First, I believe I can say without fear of contradiction that I've done more than any other person in America to bury the "death tax" in the House and to get it with one foot in the grave $OZ \in HJ OE JJS EOZ$

WH STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

in the Senate.

For over 10 years, I've been actively involved on a daily basis to win "death tax" repeal, and if I can fully activate my game plan, the "death tax" will be history. Only three more votes are needed in the Senate to bury it. I know who the three votes are and how we can sway them in our favor.

Mr. Rove, as I've said, this game plan is so simple that it may make you wonder why it has not been implemented before now. There are several reasons for that, but primarily it's because nobody, but nobody, has taken it upon themselves to do what I'm proposing. Instead there are volumes written on the subject: newspaper articles, studies by leading think tanks on both sides, even books rushed into print espousing the pros and cons of this infamous tax.

While it is good to debate the issue, there is a time to take action and I believe that time is now. Here's a brief history:

Over a 10-year period, we (the 60 Plus Association with your help) have increased support for "death tax" repeal from 19 sponsors in the House of Representatives in 1993 to over 270 votes in 1999. Unfortunately, President Clinton vetoed it as a "windfall for the wealthy," but we came back again in 2002 again with over 270 votes in the House and President Bush has promised to sign it once it reaches his desk.

However, in the Senate, because of arcane Senate rules, we need 60 votes instead of 51 votes (a simple majority). We now have 57, but we've stalled at that number. However, I've found the three votes I believe we can switch to our side.

I've studied very carefully the list of 34 senators who are up for re-election next year, 19 Democrats and 15 Republicans. Out of this number there are three Democrats who have very credible opponents, and not only that, their opponents are on record to kill the "death tax." The three U.S. Senators that I am targeting are Patty Murray of Washington, Tom Daschle of South Dakota, and Harry Reid of Nevada. (The other 16 Democrats do not yet have credible opponents).

Senator Murray is being challenged by Republican Congressman George Nethercutt, while Tom Daschle is in the fight of his life, currently trailing in the polls to former Republican Congressman John Thune. Harry Reid of Nevada is highly vulnerable, even though no opposition has yet emerged. Reid won by only a couple hundred votes five years ago.

I should mention that of the 15 Republican Senators up for re-election only one has voted against repeal. That lone Republican is Senator John McCain of Arizona. This is shocking because the original sponsor of "death tax" repeal is none other than his Republican colleague from Arizona, Senator Jon Kyl, and colleagues from the same party almost always co-sponsor each other's legislative proposals. (Jon Kyl was one of the first 19 sponsors of "death tax" repeal in the House in 1993, first introduced by Rep. Chris Cox of California).

When I campaigned with then-Congressman Kyl in Arizona in 1994 in his first election to the

U.S. Senate, he told me, without prompting, that if elected he would carry the ball in the Senate for repeal of the "death tax." At the time, there were no sponsors for repeal in the Senate.

True to his word, early in March 1995, during his first 100 days, newly elected Senator Kyl introduced the first repeal of the "death tax" in the Senate and now we have 56 other supporters.

Having said all that, I am not yet targeting Senator McCain for the very simple reason that he has no credible opposition from either political party.

I want to emphasize that my number one goal is not to defeat any of these Senators. By law, the 60 Plus Association cannot call for the election of or the defeat of any member of Congress. I want to make that clear.

Instead, my number one goal is to convince these three Senators to "see the light" as an overwhelming majority of their colleagues in the House have done (218 votes out of 435 is a majority and there were 274 votes for repeal). The same holds in the Senate where a majority is 51 out of 100 and we currently have 57 votes in favor of repeal.

When I say we can convince these three to "see the light," I'm invoking a favorite expression of the late Republican Senator from Illinois, Everett McKinley Dirksen. Senator Dirksen was fond of saying that at election time if you applied enough heat, a politician would "see the light." Senator Dirksen was right. At election time a politician focuses much more intently on issues.

With that in mind, I have reviewed how we moved from 19 sponsors for repeal in 1993 in the House to 274 in 2002 and how we moved from one sponsor for repeal in 1995 in the Senate to 57 sponsors in 2002. With the help of a lot of people we have reached these lofty numbers, but over this 10-year period the 60 Plus Association mailed 10 million letters at a cost of millions of dollars, to senior citizens all over the country.

We also did polling that showed 77% of the public would be more likely to vote for their member of the House or Senate if their member voted to abolish the "death tax." That is an incredibly high percentage and several later polls validated that high percentile, even though the vast majority of these voters are not personally affected by the "death tax."

The one theme that ran through each of these polls was that the American voting public registered strongly the assertion that it is unfair to tax assets that have already been taxed while one is alive. So it became a "fairness" issue, and as you've probably seen in the press, the 60 Plus Association's slogan "Dying should not be a taxable event" has been repeated from coast to coast.

The 60 Plus Association has pounded home the fact that this is truly a "death tax," even though the opposition likes to call it the estate tax, because the only thing that triggers it is death!

To help gain support for repeal and to keep attention on this issue, we devised a new award and presented it to House and Senate members, Democrats and Republicans alike, who voted for repeal. We called it the Benjamin Franklin Award, for it was Franklin who said, "There are two certainties in life, death and taxes." At 60 Plus, we said that because of the estate tax, there are now three certainties -1) death, 2) taxes, AND 3) taxes AFTER death! So members of the House and Senate were quoted in their hometown papers as working to get rid of that third certainty, taxes AFTER death, when they were presented with the Benjamin Franklin Award by the 60 Plus Association after they sponsored "death tax" repeal.

We even had Kill the Death Tax buttons manufactured and these were worn by members of Congress, both from the House and the Senate, to promote repeal of the "death tax." These buttons are becoming collector's items and I've enclosed one for you.

Our biggest financial backer, a gentleman from Florida, my home state, made an interesting observation after hearing me speak at the Heritage Foundation in 1995 on this issue. Introducing himself following the speech, he visited our headquarters in Arlington, Virginia, and confided that while he donated to Heritage as well as a whole host of organizations, he made the point that while those groups favored repeal of the "death tax," this was just one of dozens of issues for them while our organization, 60 Plus, devoted almost its entire budget and energy to repeal of this tax.

As *The American Spectator* points out, "Martin has never had great sums of money to bankroll his campaign. Instead he's relied on salesmanship. Martin's great skill is his ability to make an issue resonate with voters who wouldn't possibly be affected by it."

Mr. Rove, it has been a long and arduous 10-year lobbying campaign and because of sending out 10 million letters as well as countless press releases, holding press conferences, and doing hundreds of radio talk shows, we have succeeded in not only educating the general public but in convincing a majority of Congress that this tax is clearly unfair and should be repealed.

Now that this decade-long educational process is behind us and "death tax" legislation is on everybody's radar screen, I believe that a hard-hitting advertising campaign focused solely on senior citizens in those three states –Washington, South Dakota, and Nevada – will make sure that these Senators "see the light."

My game plan is to have our advertising agency gather up the names and addresses of senior citizens in these three states. In the larger state, Washington, I plan to mail to 200,000 Seniors, while in the two smaller states, South Dakota and Nevada, my goal is to mail to 100,000 senior citizens in each, for a total of 400,000 letters.

At an approximate cost of 45 cents per letter for postage, printing, paper, and postcards, my budget is \$180,000 to secure the needed three votes. Incidentally, in earlier appeals to a broad array of supporters, I targeted six Senators, the three I've mentioned here, but also Senator McCain of Arizona, Senator Byron Dorgan of North Dakota, and Senator Blanche Lincoln of Arkansas. However, I have put these last three – McCain, Dorgan, and Lincoln – on the back burner until if and when they are faced with serious challengers.

I believe \$180,000 spent wisely, that is, in small states where the challengers are not only

viable but are also strong advocates for "death tax" repeal, presents us with our best chance to gain the needed three votes to reach 60 in the Senate.

Don't get me wrong. If more resources were available, I would also like to run print ads in their hometown newspapers as well as radio and TV commercials in Washington, South Dakota, and Nevada. However, as you know, those forms of advertising are more of a "shotgun" approach while the mailbox allows us to use "rifle shots," hitting those voters who have more of an interest in this issue than the general population.

Mr. Rove, I'm going to conclude this letter by asking you to be on a team of a half dozen individuals that will commit to donating, or helping to raise, \$20,000 each for this project. You and the other five individuals would be responsible for \$120,000 of this \$180,000 goal. (I have gotten a commitment from another long time activist to try and raise the other \$60,000).

One final observation: including you, the other five individuals that I hope to convince to participate in this project will remain anonymous. Over our 10-year history the 60 Plus Association has received donations from more than a quarter million individuals, the average being about \$20, and we have a policy of not revealing their names or the amounts they have given unless they specifically ask us to.

While the average donation is \$20, we were fortunate to have one individual contribute \$100,000 to our efforts to repeal this tax, the gentleman referred to earlier in this letter that I met at the Heritage Foundation. I can give you more details on how we utilized his money to help lock-in crucial support for "death tax" repeal. It makes an interesting story.

Mr. Rove, there are many who are familiar with my work to kill this tax – starting with delivering a truckload of petitions to Capitol Hill 10 years ago to focus attention on this issue.

A few you could check with include: Bill Beach at the Heritage Foundation (202-608-6206), Peter Uhlmann, Chief of Staff to Rep. Chris Cox (R-CA), the original sponsor of the "death tax" repeal (202-225-5611), and Tim Glazewski, Chief of Staff to Senator Jon Kyl, the Senate sponsor (202-224-4521).

At the White House, one of the National Economic Council's economists is Brian Reardon (202-456-0360) And the country's top attorney who has worked tirelessly to rid the tax code of this monstrosity is Harold Apolinsky of Birmingham, Alabama, a partner at Sirote and Permutt.

Harold and I shared a panel some years ago before the House Ways and Means Committee, urging abolition of this confiscatory tax. Harold's phone number is 202-933-7111.

In conclusion, I honestly believe that if we are ready to go before the next major vote, and I'm

not sure when that will occur, we can finally abolish this onerous tax, this confiscatory, jobrobbing, anti-business tax.

I say, let's kill the death tax, not wound it! We have a wonderful opportunity to do so. As I stated earlier, please feel free to call me at anytime, and I'll be glad to answer any questions and I would most welcome your opinion.

I anxiously await your answer.

I have had dozens of articles written about me and the 60 Plus Association I've headed since its inception, and while I don't expect you to read them all, I have enclosed several that I think illustrate my contention that nobody in America has done more to kill the death tax. The Mr. Death article appeared in one of the country's most liberal publications, *The American Prospect*, and while the author made a couple of snide comments, on balance it is a favorable piece. One clarification. The article implies that I take credit for coining the "death tax" term, but Bill Gates, Sr. said it correctly in a recent book, "one significant player in <u>advancing</u> the 'death tax' term was Jim Martin, a long-time activist who founded 60 Plus."

P.P.S. There's so much going for us on this issue. For example, the South Dakota legislature voted by an 80-20 margin to endorse repeal of the "death tax." I want to remind South Dakota's senior citizen voters of that fact when we write them to point out that Senator Daschle is in a distinct minority in the U.S. Senate on this issue.

Mr. Rove, if you feel you cannot participate at the level I've suggested at this time, either a donation of \$20,000 or raising that amount from your friends, I'll understand. But any donation, perhaps in the \$2,000, \$5,000, or \$10,000 range will help us attain our goal. MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Enrolled Bill H.R. 3146 - Extension of Expiring Welfare, Health, and User Fee Programs

Sponsor - Rep. Thomas (R) CA

Last Day for Action

We recommend approval as soon as possible to minimize disruption of the programs that are extended by this enrolled bill.

Purpose

Extends certain welfare, health, and user fee programs that expire on September 30, 2003.

Discussion

The Congress has not yet completed action on long-term welfare reform reauthorization legislation. H.R. 3146 provides a short-term extension of expiring welfare programs. It also includes

short-term extensions of expiring health and user fee programs.

Welfare and Health Programs

Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). TANF is a block grant program that provides funding to States for time-limited and work-conditioned aid to low-income families with children. Under TANF, each State is entitled to a fixed annual sum based on certain expenditures. Most TANF provisions were scheduled to expire on October 1, 2002, but have been extended under temporary authority. Most recently, P.L. 108-40 extended TANF funding through September 30, 2003, based on the FY 2002 level of \$17 billion. H.R. 3146 would extend authorizations and funding at FY 2002 levels through March 31, 2004, for TANF provisions including: (1) grants to States, territories, and Indian tribes; (2) supplemental grants for population increases in certain States; (3) the Contingency Fund from which eligible States may draw during economic downturns; and (4) funds to continue TANF and child welfare research.

In addition, H.R. 3146 would extend authorizations and funding at FY 2002 levels through March 31, 2004, for the child care entitlement program and the abstinence education program. The child care program provides grants to States to provide child care assistance, with a focus on families who are receiving, attempting to transition off, or at risk of becoming dependent on TANF assistance. (Both the FY 2002 appropriation and the FY 2004 Budget request for this program were \$2.7 billion.) The abstinence education program provides for allotments to States to offer instruction on the social, psychological, and health benefits of abstaining from sexual activity and, at the State's option, counseling to promote abstinence. (For FY 2002, \$50 million was appropriated; the FY 2004 Budget requested the extension of this program for an additional five years at \$50 million annually.)

H.R. 3146 also would extend, through March 31, 2004, the FY 2002 authorizations for the Transitional Medicaid Assistance (TMA) program and child welfare demonstration projects. The TMA program provides access to Medicaid coverage for up to one year for former TANF recipients after they enter the workforce. Under the enrolled bill, TMA would not be available to families that lose TANF eligibility after March 31, 2004. Child welfare demonstration projects are intended to identify and address issues such as barriers that result in delays to adoptive placements for children in foster care. The enrolled bill would extend, through March 31, 2004, the time period within which HHS may authorize States to conduct these demonstrations.

<u>Medicare Cost Sharing</u>. H.R. 3146 also would extend, through March 2004, Medicare costsharing for Part B (Physician) premiums for qualifying individuals (the so-called QI-1 program). The enrolled bill would continue to have Medicaid pay the Part B premium (currently \$58.70 per month) for Medicare beneficiaries whose income is between 120 and 135 percent of the Federal poverty level. The Federal Government would reimburse the States for the entire cost of this program. The FY 2004 Budget called for a five-year extension of the program. The QI-1 program expires on September 30, 2003.

<u>Standardized Medicare Inpatient Hospital Payments</u>. In Medicare's hospital payment system, the base payment rate for large urban hospitals is higher than that for other urban and rural hospitals. According to Congress's Medicare Advisory Commission, there is no statistically significant difference between large urban and other hospitals for the costs captured by the base rate. Public Law 108-7 equalized payments between large urban and other hospitals for the six- month period ending September 30, 2003. H.R. 3146 would extend this provision through March 31, 2004.

User Fee and Tax Provisions

<u>Customs User Fees</u>. The Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) of 1985, as amended, authorizes the collection of fees for providing various customs inspectional services, including the processing of air and sea passengers, commercial vehicles, vessels, and rail cars. This fee authority expires on September 30, 2003. The enrolled bill would extend the fee authority through March 31, 2004. The FY 2004 Budget proposed that the fees be reauthorized for ten years. OMB estimates that the Customs user fee extension would increase revenues by \$698 million in FY 2004.

IRS User Fees. H.R. 3146 would extend, through December 31, 2004, the authorization for the IRS to collect user fees for certain requests to the IRS for ruling letters, opinion letters, and determination letters. The current authority expires on September 30, 2003. These letters provide responses to questions from individuals, corporations, and organizations relating to their tax status or the effects of particular transactions for tax purposes. The fees must be paid in advance and range from \$85 to \$6,500, based on the complexity of each category of request. Your FY 2004 Budget proposed extending the user fee authority through September 30, 2005.

IRS Student Loan Verification Program. H.R. 3146 would extend for 15 months, until December 31, 2004, a provision in current law that allows the IRS to share tax return information with the Department of Education for the purpose of administering income-contingent student loans. This authority allows Education to verify adjusted gross income, filing status, and identity information. However, Education informally advises that, because the current provision does not permit Education to redisclose this information to its contractors, it does not currently use this authority, but instead receives written consent from income-contingent loan borrowers that authorizes IRS to release this verification information.

Conclusion and Recommendations

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) recommends approval of H.R. 3146 as soon as possible, so as to avoid disruptions that would result upon expiration of programs on September 30th.

We join HHS in recommending approval of H.R. 3146, which passed the House by voice vote and the Senate by unanimous consent.

To congratulate Bill Haslam on being elected Mayor of Knoxville, Tennessee, on September 30.

Bill Haslam, son of Pilot Corp. founder and Bush-Cheney Tennessee Finance Chair Jim Haslam, was elected Mayor of Knoxville in Tuesday's nonpartisan primary election. Haslam was supported by more than 50 percent of those who voted; therefore there will be no general election. Haslam will take over on December 20 from four-term Mayor Victor Ashe who could not seek re-election due to term limits.

Haslam won with 15,727 votes or 53 percent of the vote. His leading challenger former Knox County commissioner and urban planner Madeline Rogero (Roe-HAIR-oh) received 13,860 votes or 46 percent and perennial candidates Boyce McCall and George Alexander Hamilton received 123 votes and 166 votes respectively. By mid-September Haslam had raised \$580,000 and Rogero had raised \$155,700.

Bill Haslam stepped down as President of Pilot Corp. to join the race for Mayor.

Sharing the ballot were 12 candidates for four City Council seats and two contenders for City Judge. The city council seats will be ultimately decided in the November 4 general election. Knoxville City Court Judge John Rosson was reelected for a fifth term over Mark Jendrek.

When we met last Spring one of the things you were kind of enough to offer to help with was the presidential appointments to the Board of the Help America Vote Foundation (not the Commission, the Foundation created under HAVA Title VI dealing with high school students as poll workers).

And, in response to your suggestion to him that he help, Leonard Rodriguez asked for potential appointments months ago and I sent him a solid list.

No confirmation is necessary but the appointments have not been made, the board doesn't exist, therefore the foundation doesn't exist, and no funds can be dispersed to it. If the appointments aren't made prior to the end of the fiscal year in a couple of weeks the minimal f2003 funds will be lost (and there were no f2004 funds appropriated).

I worked hard to get the provision in the bill and the f2003 funds appropriated for it. So I'd hate to see it all die.

I know that in the scheme of things it is not a big deal, but I would appreciate your help.
