



Janet Parshall says the book she
wrote with her first-born daughter,
Sarah, When the Fairy Dust Settles, is
a primer in apologetics. It gets to the
heart of what one really believes, just
like her popular radio show does.
Janet and Sarah share letters that
they wrote to each other addressing
issues like body image and self worth.
Janet says this is similar to the way
Paul was able to impart wisdom to
Timothy.

An intimate form of communication. the book encourages open dialogue between mothers and daughters and between the older and younger generations. Janet believes the older generation must distinguish between major issues and minor issues, and impart the truth based on the major issues. As an example, Janet says someone won't go to hell for getting a facelift, but an issue like this is cultural with a biblical heart. Sarah believes that biblical issues are major and cultural issues are minor. Getting to the root of the issue will lead to the biblical truth.

Janet says there is a problem today with integrative faith – there is a disconnect between how people live and what the Bible says, a distinction between culture and faith. Because of this, Janet believes women should be critical, biblical thinkers. She and Sarah chose the use of fairy tales in

their book to point women back to the truths of the Bible. Women must distinguish between faith, fantasy, and fact.

Many women have grown up expecting their real lives to mirror the happy endings found in fairy tales. Janet and Sarah want Christian women to understand that in the Lord, women are real-life princesses and that the real world is temporary and doesn't usually have a happy fairy tale ending. Eternity with Jesus is the true "happily ever after." Janet notes that our culture is going back to fairy tales and there is another generation of girls to

believe the myths. Sarah wants the women of her generation to find hope through this message.

The Thought Police

The Parshalls lived a great life in Wisconsin with Janet's husband, Craig, practicing law and Janet being a full-time mother to their four children. Janet came to politics about 19 years ago when Sarah came home from 5th grade with a troubling school assignment. Over dinner Sarah told her family that her teacher, as part of an experimental program in self-esteem, asked Sarah whether or not she wet her bed or bit her



nails and with whom she would live if her parents got a divorce.

Disturbed by this type of teaching, Janet made an appointment with school administrators to complain. When she and Craig arrived, they faced a table of school officials who treated them as if they were on trial. Janet says one official asked if she "was opposed to secular humanism." This was an "aha" moment, and Janet asked him what secular humanism was. Clearing his throat, he said he didn't know. Janet said, "Well, sir, if you don't know, what difference does it make if I'm for it or against it?"

This incident transformed Janet from being a PTA mom to being part of the "right wing." Craig and Janet began talking with other concerned parents and speaking out at every opportunity. It was an epiphany for Janet, opening her eyes to the reality and intensity of spiritual warfare and the fact that she had to equip her children. She realized she had to impart to them the Bible and how to apply it in their lives.

The Achilles heel for Christian parents is their children, says Janet, and parents need to be aware of this. Because of this, the Parshall's dinner table became the forum for family discussions.

Janet totally immersed herself in the Word of God and started to learn apologetics. It was the first time she discovered that there was a major disconnect between reading the Word and applying it.

Christians must increase their discernment and impart the Word. Janet says that as Christians we're too lazy to decipher the Word, so we are wooed by the world's system and are deceived. The Word is the bottom line, and we must pass it on to the next generation. There needs to be an understanding of critical biblical truth.

Sarah says that even in the 5th grade she had a sense that the assignment was wrong. Before this incident, she knew right from wrong and the family had forum discussions. Her parents gave her a strong foundation. They led by example, and it was a natural progression.

Sarah and her siblings were politically active as teens. Sarah says her parents taught her and her siblings how to be courageous in their faith. By the time she got to college, Sarah really felt she got the opportunities to demonstrate this. Sarah hopes to pass the values she learned on to her son.

Sarah's Story

Sarah vividly remembers accepting the Lord when she was 6. She prayed with her mother and really desired the Christian life that was modeled to her by her parents. Sarah's father was much like Atticus Finch of the novel *To Kill a Mockingbird*, a lawyer in a small firm interested in making a difference in people's

college where she explored her own beliefs. She found it beneficial and learned that everyone goes through stages of exploration to discover their individual relationship to Jesus. While in college, Sarah established her own personal relationship with Christ.

She worked in her father's law firm after college, and then worked in another firm after getting her law degree. She subsequently worked in a small advertising agency. Now she stays at home with her infant son. She believes it is important for her to be available for her son in his formative years just as her mother was there for her and her siblings.

Bio (Novak)

Michael Novak received the Templeton Prize for Progress in Religion (a million-dollar purse awarded at Buckingham Palace) in 1994, and delivered the Templeton address in Westminster Abbey. He has also received the Boyer Award in 1999; with Milton Friedman and Vaclav Klaus the International Prize by the Institution for World Capitalism; the Antony Fisher Prize for *The Spirit of Democratic Capitalism* presented by Margaret Thatcher; the Weber Award for contributions to Catholic Social Thought in Essen, Germany; the Cezanne Medal from the City of Provence, and the Catholic Culture Medal of Bassano del Grappa in Italy; the highest civilian award from the Slovak Republic in 1996; the Masaryk Medal, presented by Vaclav Havel of the Czech Republic, in 2000; and in December 2001, the Gold Medal of The Pennsylvania Society.

Theologian, author, and former U.S. ambassador, Michael Novak currently holds the George Frederick Jewett Chair in Religion and Public Policy at the American Enterprise Institute in Washington, D.C., where he is Director of Social and Political Studies.

His writings have appeared in every major Western language, and in Bengali, Korean and Japanese. His masterpiece, *The Spirit of Democratic Capitalism*, has been reprinted often in Latin America, and was published underground in Poland in 1984, and recently in Czechoslovakia, Germany, China and Hungary. One reviewer called it "one of those rare books that actually changed the world."

Mr. Novak has written some 25 influential books in the philosophy and theology of culture, including: The Open Church (1964), Belief and Unbelief (1965,1994), The Experience of Nothingness (1970, 1998), The Rise of the Unmeltable Ethnics (1972,1996), The Guns of Lattimer (1976,1996), Moral Clarity in the Nuclear Age (1983), Will It Liberate? Questions About Liberation Theology (1986), and Free Persons and the Common Good (1989). Together with the Lay Commission on Catholic Social Teaching and the U.S. Economy, he wrote Toward the Future (1984) and, with a scholarly committee, The New Consensus on Family and Welfare (1987). His other books include This Hemisphere of Liberty (1990), The Catholic Ethic and the Spirit of Capitalism (1993), The Joy of Sports (1976,1994), To Empower People: From State to Civil Society (1996), Business as a Calling (1996); The Fire of Invention (1997), and with his daughter Jana Novak, Tell Me Why: A Father Answers His Daughter's Questions About God (1998); On Cultivating Liberty (1999); A Free Society Reader (2000); and his newest book, On Two Wings (2001). Mr. Novak has also published two novels: The Tiber was Silver (1961), Naked I Leave (1970).

His essays and reviews have been published in *The New Republic, Commentary, Harper's, First Things, The Atlantic, The New York Times Magazine*, and *National Review*, as well as *Theological Studies, The Yale Law Journal, The Public Interest, The Review of Politics*, and many other journals here and overseas.

"Illusions and Realities," his twice-weekly column was syndicated nationally from 1976-1980 and was a Pulitzer finalist in 1979. He took leave of the column in 1980 to complete two books and resumed weekly publication in 1984. He wrote a regular column in *The Commonweal* from March 1972 until July 1975. He was writer in residence at *The Washington Star* in 1976. His column "Tomorrow and Tomorrow" appeared monthly in *National Review* from 1979 until 1986. From 1989 to 1994 *Forbes* ran his occasional column, "The Larger Context."

He serves on editorial boards of several publications and organizations here and abroad. He was cofounder of *This World, Crisis*, and *First Things*, and was publisher/editor of *Crisis* until 1996.

In 1974, Mr. Novak campaigned for the creation of a White House Office of Ethnic Affairs. The office was opened during the Ford administration, continued under President Carter, and Mr. Novak served as an advisor during both administrations.

Mr. Novak was appointed and served as: Ambassador of the U.S. Delegation to the UN Human Rights Commission in Geneva, 1981-1982; head of the U.S. Delegation to the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe (the monitor of the Helsinki Accords), 1986; with Senate approval, member of the Board for International Broadcasting (the private corporation that governs Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty), 1984-1994; member of the Presidential Task Force on Project Economic Justice, 1985. He has served the United States during both Democratic and Republican administrations.

His teaching career began as a Teaching Fellow at Harvard. From 1965-68 he was Assistant Professor of Humanities at Stanford, where in two out of his three years, the senior class voted him one of the two "most influential professors." From 1968 to 1973 he taught at the newly formed experimental College at SUNY Old Westbury. During 1973-1974, Mr. Novak launched the new humanities program at the Rockefeller Foundation. In 1976 he accepted a tenured chair as University Professor and Ledden-Watson Distinguished Professor of Religion at Syracuse University. He held the W. Harold and Martha Welch chair as Professor of American Studies at the University of Notre Dame for the autumn semesters of 1987 and 1988. Intrigued by the relationship between religion and economics, he joined AEI as a Resident Scholar in the spring of 1978.

He graduated (Summa Cum Laude) from Stonehill College (B.A., Philosophy and English) in 1956 and the Gregorian University in Rome (B.A. Theology, Cum Laude) in 1958. He continued theological studies at Catholic University and then at Harvard, where he received an M.A. in 1966 in History and the Philosophy of Religion. ABOUT GARY BAUER FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2007



Gary L. Bauer is one of America's most effective spokesmen for pro-life, pro-family, and pro-growth values. Bauer is a frequent guest on a wide variety of political talk shows and a much-in-demand speaker nationwide.

Bauer served in President Ronald Reagan's administration for eight years, as Under Secretary of Education and as President Reagan's Chief Domestic Policy Advisor. While serving at the Education Department, Bauer was named Chairman of President Reagan's Special Working Group on the Family. His report, "The Family: Preserving America's Future," was presented to the President in December 1986.

Completing his service in the Reagan White House in late 1988, Gary Bauer became President of the Family Research Council and a Senior Vice President of Focus on the

Family. The Family Research Council is one of Washington's most respected centers for public policy. In ten years, Bauer led FRC from a three person, \$1 million operation, to a 120 person, \$14 million operation, housed in its own headquarters in downtown Washington.

In 1996, Bauer launched the Campaign for Working Families, a political action committee dedicated to electing profamily, pro-life conservatives to public office. In its first two years of operation, Campaign for Working Families raised \$7 million with 90,000 individual contributors and today remains one of America's largest conservative political action committees.

Bauer took his unapologetically pro-family, pro-life message across the country in 1999 and into the 2000 Republican presidential debates and primaries. Stressing the sanctity of life and traditional marriage, Bauer made family-friendly policies and combating judicial activism key platforms of his campaign.


He has continued to champion these and other causes at American Values, a non-profit educational organization Bauer founded after the 2000 presidential campaign. From American Values Bauer has authored numerous op-ed pieces making the case for a federal marriage protection amendment and stressing the urgent need to rein in rogue judges. A vocal opponent of the "stealth strategy" for Supreme Court nominations, Bauer was an early critic of the nomination of Harriet Miers and enthusiastically backed Samuel Alito. During the Roberts and Alito Supreme Court confirmation hearings, Bauer was quoted more than one thousand times in newspapers across the country making the case for a conservative Supreme Court nominee.

A staunch supporter of President Bush's war on terrorism, Bauer is also a leading Christian advocate for a strong and secure Israel. Since the atrocities of September 11th, Bauer has devoted considerable time and energy to strengthening the shared values of the Israeli/American alliance.

Bauer is the author of <u>Our Journey Home</u>, published in October 1992; co-author of <u>Children at Risk: The Battle for the Hearts and Minds of Our Kids</u> written with Focus on the Family Chairman and Founder, Dr. James Dobson; author of <u>Our Hopes</u>, <u>Our Dreams: A Vision for America</u>, published in 1998, and <u>Doing Things Right</u>, published in 2001.

In 1973, Bauer received his law degree from Georgetown Law School in Washington D.C. He is married to the former Carol Hoke of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and lives in Virginia. Gary and Carol Bauer have three grown children.

We hope this letter, written to you and the people of the great nation of Israel from your friends in the United States, will be an encouragement. We want to remind the Israeli people that they are not alone in their hour of need.

On September 11, 2001 the United States suffered a horrendous attack. As we mourned our losses we were shocked to see dancing in the streets, in celebration of our pain, in some parts of the Middle East. But in Israel you cried with us and lowered your flag and shared our grief. On September 11th many Americans came to understand for the first time what it is like to be an Israeli and to face barbaric terrorism that targets innocent civilians. We know that in the face of this evil the free people of the world who believe in human dignity, the sanctity of life and in free institutions must stand together.

We know you have been America's reliable friend and ally and we understand that our friendship is natural because both of our nations are built on Western Civilization, and its foundation of Judeo-Christian values.

Please know that we are committed, as are millions of Christians in America, to praying for Israel and for the "peace of Jerusalem". We also are committed to working to ensure that the great evil that threatens America and Israel does not prevail.

We believe Israel has the same right of self-defense that all sovereign nations enjoy. We believe you have shown incredible restraint in the face of the wanton violence aimed at innocent Israeli civilians. We reject the notion that America or Israel should be passive in the face of such violence. We know that just as our country has the right to track down the terrorists who have declared war on America that you too have the right to pursue those who are dedicated to destroying you.

We believe terrorists cannot be appeased and we reject all pressure on Israel to do so.

We believe the suffering of Palestinian Arabs is due to the failure of their leaders to provide any vision for the future, other than hatred of Israel and self-destruction.
