### NATIONAL LATINO FRATERNITY OPPOSES UNIVISION-HBC SPANISH-LANGUAGE MEDIA MERGER

**CLIFTON, NJ, September 3, 2003** –Lambda Theta Phi, the nation's oldest and largest Latino fraternity, announced today that this month it will begin staging rallies, conducting letter writing campaigns, and holding lectures and hearings across the country in opposition to the proposed merger of Univision and the Hispanic Broadcasting Corporation (HBC). The organization believes this merger will mitigate the responsiveness of Spanish-language broadcasting to local communities and eliminate Hispanic ownership of Spanish-language media. In addition to the rallies, a Lambda Theta Phi delegation will seek a meeting with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), congressional legislators and White House representatives.

Established in 1975, Lambda Theta Phi has 80 college student chapters and thousands more alumni members active across the country. With this announcement, the fraternity joins a predominantly Hispanic contingent of congressional representatives, the Hispanic Americans for Fairness in Media, the Consumer Federation of America, the Spanish Broadcasting System (SBS), the Hispanic Organization of Latin Actors (HOLA), the United Latino Fund, and other groups to block FCC approval of a merger that will monopolize 70% of Spanish-language advertising revenue in the US by creating a TV, cable, music and internet conglomerate. The merger will eliminate any current competition and create insurmountable barriers to the Hispanic media market for newcomers.

In addition to their own members, Lambda Theta Phi plans to reach out to all the national and local Latin fraternities and sororities across the country to join the effort. They will also ask the alumni membership, made up predominantly of young Hispanic professionals, to enlist the aid of their families and other organizations they may be involved in to support them in opposing this merger. The fraternity is against one company having unilateral control over the access to broadcast marketing and editorial opportunities in the Hispanic media. The organization has also expressed grave concerns over the possibility of FCC approval, which will allow for Hispanic media to be controlled by one individual who is a non-Hispanic.

Lambda Theta Phi National President Jorge Diaz said: "This is a question of what's right. This kind of monopoly would never be considered for approval in the English language media, so why is it acceptable for the Hispanic market? Fair competition, opportunity, diversity of opinions and Hispanic ownership of Hispanic media is something we're passionate about. A recent poll by *Opiniones Latinas* revealed that 87 percent of Hispanic Americans are opposed to both the idea of non-Hispanics controlling Hispanic media, as well as any politicians that would support such an idea. The FCC is trying to decide on this merger away from the scrutiny of the Hispanic community, and we are committed to seeing that it doesn't happen."

HBC, the nation's largest owner of Spanish-language radio stations, has its controlling interest owned by Clear Channel, the single largest radio company in the world. The merger would combine HBC with Univision, the largest Hispanic television network, which is controlled by Jerry Perenchio, who is a non-Hispanic. In the hands of Perenchio, a high-profile Republican, Univision has been criticized by Lambda Theta Phi and others for being one-sided in its presentation of political and social issues as well as giving a very limited portrayal of Hispanics, with most of its prime time entertainment produced in Mexico or Venezuela. One fraternity spokesman made it clear that Perenchio's political affiliations were not the issue, but rather keeping Hispanic media as an open forum for all political perspectives, "Lambda Theta Phi is a non-partisan organization so this is not about choosing political sides. Our concern is that Hispanic media represent all viewpoints in our community, and we feel that the proposed Univision-HBC merger may threaten the possibility of opposing views being represented in the Hispanic media. This is not just a Hispanic issue; this is an issue for everyone that believes in the integrity of the public airwayes. It's also important to remember that control of the media can influence Hispanic voters, which can shape future national elections."

Founded in 1975 at Kean University in Union, New Jersey, Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc. is the first college Greek-letter organization founded as a Latin Fraternity. The membership of Lambda Theta Phi is open to all college men who support its values of scholarship, respect for all cultures, community service, and the advancement and fair treatment of Latinos. Lambda Theta Phi was the first Latin Fraternity to be recognized by the National Interfraternity Conference (NIC) and today has 80 chapters in New York, Florida, California, Texas, New Jersey, Arizona, Connecticut, Illinois, New Mexico, Michigan, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia. "Labor, environmental and women's organizations, with strong backing from international financier George Soros, have joined forces behind a new political group that plans to spend an unprecedented \$75 million to mobilize voters to defeat President Bush in 2004. The organization, Americans Coming Together (ACT), will conduct 'a massive get-out-the-vote operation that we think will defeat George W. Bush in 2004,' said Ellen Malcolm, the president of EMILY's List, who will become ACT's president. ACT already has commitments for more than \$30 million, Malcolm and others said, including \$10 million from Soros, \$12 million from six other philanthropists, and about \$8 million from unions, including the Service Employees International Union. In a statement describing his reasons for giving \$10 million, Soros said, 'I believe deeply in the values of an open society. For the past 15 years I have focused my energies on fighting for these values abroad. Now I am doing it in the United States. The fate of the world depends on the United States and President Bush is leading us in the wrong direction.'" (*The Washington Post, August 08, 2003*)

"I believe deeply in the values of an open society. For the past 15 years I have focused my energies on fighting for these values abroad,' said Soros, who donated \$1 billion to prodemocracy efforts in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union. 'Now I am doing it in the United States...The fate of the world depends on the United States and President Bush is leading us in the wrong direction,' he said in a statement from his New York investment office. 'The Bush doctrine is both false and dangerous. The rest of the world is having an allergic reaction to it, as we have seen in Iraq. We need to change direction.'"(*Scripps Howard News Service, August 08, 2003*)

"International financer and philanthropist George Soros Monday announced that he was sharply curtailing his activities in Russia to focus on another country where civil society was under threat: the United States. He said he had lately become 'preoccupied with problems of globalisation ... and the role the United States plays' in world affairs. 'The struggle for a global open society must be fought primarily in the United States, because the United States has clearly become the dominant power in the world ... As an American citizen. I feel that the current US administration is abusing its power by trying to increase that power instead of using it to try to create a more peaceful and equitable world,' he said. The situation in the United States has become 'quite dangerous,' he said, 'because the executive branch has come under the influence of a group of ideologues who have forgotten the first principle of an open society: that they don't have a monopoly of the truth.' The US administration has 'abused the terror attack (of September 11, 2001)' as a pretext 'for an extension of executive power beyond the appropriate degree,' he said. Above all, Soros warned, it has introduced the 'very dangerous' Bush doctrine which claims the right to preemptive military action. 'Taken to its logical conclusion, this means that there are now two kinds of sovereignty in the world: the sovereignty of the United States that overrides all international obligations and treaties, and the sovereignty of other countries which is subject to the Bush doctrine... This is reminiscent of George Orwell's dictum in 'Animal Farm' that all animals are equal, but some are more equal than others.' The current view in Washington that 'there is only one model of democracy, that of the United States' is 'as false, and potentially as dangerous, as that of the Communists' belief

that there is only one way to organise society,' Soros said. However 'America remains a democracy,' he stressed, voicing the hope 'that Americans will reject this view of the world.'" (Agence France Presse, June 9, 2003)

"I am profoundly opposed to the Bush administration's policies, not only in Iraq but altogether. My opposition is much more profound than it was in the case of the Clinton administration. I believe the Bush administration is leading the United States and the world in the wrong direction... Now I would go so far as to say that the fight for a global open society has to be fought in the United States. In short, America ought to play a very different role in the world than it is playing today... Bush makes absolutely no allowance for the possibility that we may be wrong, and he has no tolerance for dissenting opinion. If you are not with us you are against us, he proclaims. Donald Rumsfeld berates our European allies who disagree with him on Iraq in no uncertain terms, and he has a visceral aversion to international cooperation, be it with NATO or UN peacekeepers in Afghanistan. And John Ashcroft accuses those who opposed the USA Patriot Act of giving aid and comfort to the enemy. These are the views of extremists, not adherents to an open society... It is not merely that the Bush administration's policies may be wrong, it is that they are wrong, and I would go even further: They are bound to be wrong because they are based on a false ideology. A dominant faction within the Bush administration believes than international relations are relations of power... The Bush doctrine is built on two pillars: First, the United States will do everything in its power to maintain its unquestioned military supremacy, and second, the United States arrogates the right to preemptive action. Taken together, these two pillars support two classes of sovereignty: the sovereignty of the United States, which takes precedence over international treaties and obligations, and the sovereignty of all other states, which is subject to the Bush doctrine. This is reminiscent of George Orwell's Animal Farm: All animals are equal but some are more equal than others. To be sure, the Bush doctrine is not stated so starkly; it is buried in Orwellian doublespeak. The doublespeak is needed because there is a contradiction between the Bush administration's concepts of freedom and democracy and the principles of open society... The objective of disarming Saddam Hussein was a valid one, but the way the U.S. government has gone about it is not. That is why there was so much opposition to the war throughout the world and at home. That is why I shall remain opposed to the Bush administration's conduct of foreign policy... The Bush administration claims to be fostering democracy by invading Iraq. But democracy cannot be imposed from the outside... To claim that we are invading Iraq for the sake of establishing democracy is a sham, and the rest of the world sees it as such... The Bush administration's policies have brought about many unintended, adverse consequences. Indeed, it is difficult to find a similar time span during which political and economic conditions have deteriorated as rapidly as they have in the last couple of years... I firmly believe that President Bush is leading the United States and the world in the wrong direction and I consider it nothing short of tragic that the terrorist threat has induced the country to line up behind him so uncritically... The Bush administration is deliberately fostering fear because it helps to keep the nation lined up behind the president... The Bush vision of American supremacy is not only unsound and unsustainable, it is also in contradiction with American values." (By George Soros; The American Prospect, June, 2003)
- "George Soros, the billionaire financier and philanthropist, said Thursday he disapproved of US President George W. Bush's decision to take 'preemptive' military action against Iraq. 'Whether you can introduce democracy by force I am not quite sure,' he said on a visit to the former Soviet republic of Azerbaijan where is funding a number of democracybuilding initiatives. 'The United States is encountering many problems in Iraq and I can only hope that it will not put us off from other more creative and more affirmative ways of building democracy...I am critical of the Bush doctrine of preemptive military action and I propose the Soros doctrine of preemptive action of a constructive nature where you extend help and support to countries that are moving in the direction.'" (Agence France Presse, May 29, 2003)
  - "Soros also weighed in against the tax cut plans, which include abolishing dividend taxes, even though he said he believed it was right to run a deficit to escape recessions. 'However, this move is not designed to have much effect now. It is meant to have an effect over an extended period and is basically using the recession to redistribute income to the wealthy,' Soros told CNBC financial news television. 'I think that is really not a very effective way of using a deficit. I think we do need right now both a stimulative monetary policy and a temporary deficit, not a permanent one."" (*Agence France Presse, May 21, 2003*)
- "The Bush policies have already caused severe unintended adverse consequences. The Atlantic Alliance is in a shambles and the European Union divided. The US is a fearful giant throwing its weight around. Afghanistan has been liberated but law and order have not been established beyond Kabul. The Israeli-Palestinian conflict festers. Beyond Iraq, an even more dangerous threat looms in North Korea. The global economy is in recession, stocks are in a bear market and the dollar is in decline. In the US, there has been a dramatic shift from budget surplus to deficit. It is difficult to find a time when political and economic conditions have deteriorated as rapidly" (*By George Soros; Financial Times (London) March 13, 2003*)

"US financier George Soros on Monday criticized the economic stimulus plan proposed by President George W. Bush, saying it was aimed mainly at 'the rich' and would likely push up interest rates. 'We do need stimulus, but it has to be short-term and temporary,' Soros told a forum in Washington. 'I think the stimulus is actually a misnomer,' he said of the Bush plan, adding that it 'would basically benefit the rich.' Soros spoke about Bush's 674 billion dollar economic package unveiled last week that seeks to eliminate taxes on dividends paid to investors and accelerate other planned tax cuts. 'It's actually going to hinder the recovery,' Soros said, saying the impact of higher budget deficits would be felt on long-term interest rates when the economy regains strength. 'Right now we can afford (stimulus) ... interest rates will not be affected while we are in a recession. But the moment we come out of the recession, we're going to have much higher interest rates because of the looming budget deficits."" (Agence France Presse, January 13, 2003)

"The terror attacks on Americans were a tragic lesson for U.S. leaders on the need to seek cooperation and avoid 'high-handed' moves against other nations, billionaire financier George Soros said Thursday. The U.S. effort to draw together an international coalition to fight terrorism in the wake of last week's assaults was an abrupt switch from President Bush's initial foreign policy bent of going it alone, Soros told reporters and executives at a gathering in Hong Kong. 'I think the Bush administration is now realizing that they do need to build alliances, and they have to be sensitive to the concerns of others. They can't just move high-handedly and unilaterally,' Soros said. 'Nobody has that kind of power.' 'I think this tragedy has brought this home to America,' he said. Soros, 71, urged a cautious and patient response to the attacks, noting that public reaction could tip the balance in some countries, such as Pakistan and Egypt, in favor of antagonistic Islamic fundamentalist movements. 'We have suffered a big blow, and it's hard to take it without the instinct of hitting back, but I think we really have to restrain ourselves because the dangers are enormous,' said Soros, who was born in Hungary but moved to the United States in 1956. 'If there is a positive fallout from this horrific event, it is that the Bush administration must realize we have to be concerned about the reactions of others,' he said." (*The Associated Press, September 20, 2001*)

But this concern - the rationale usually advanced for eliminating the estate tax — can be addressed by amending the existing estate tax system. Let's fix the estate tax, not repeal it! Signed. Dear Fran:

It was great to meet you today and talk about the TR sites. This is the memo you requested on TR Birthplace National Historic Site, 28 East 20th Street, New York City.

For many years the schedule at TR Birthplace NHS was --open Wednesday -Sunday, closed Monday & Tuesday. After the tragedy of 9/11/01, which necessitated the closing of many public sites for a time, TRB switched to a Monday-Friday, closed Saturday and Sunday schedule. This is neither smart or right. Working people and family groups were thereby denied access to "Roosevelt House," as we used to call it. That's wrong. Monday and Tuesday are the normal days for closing museums in New York City. It has been argued, in response to our protests, that three week days are not sufficient to serve the visiting school groups. Three days were always sufficient for this before, and I seriously doubt there has been a dramatic increase in the number of school groups. It has also been argued that school groups should be given priority over the general public. I don't agree. Balance is what is needed here, fairness to the entire population. I have also heard it argued that it's too expensive to stay open on weekends. To that I say, ok then close on three weekdays rather than two. But it is absurd to keep a museum closed on weekends.

After a long struggle, the New York sites have agreed to open on Saturdays, and that should be happening right about now. But we would also like to see the site open on Sundays as well, like any normal museum.

To Fran Mainella:

Today we talked about the acquisition by the National Park Service of the 6, 600 acres of (ranch) land adjoining the Elkhorn Ranch Unit of Theodore Roosevelt National Park in North Dakota. The acquisition of this land was endorsed at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Theodore Roosevelt Association, October 10, 2002.

I am sending you by mail a copy of the full resolution.

Among other subjects, we briefly discussed possible multiple uses of the land in question. The clause in the above resolution on the matter is:

" Be it further resolved, that multiple uses of the land, specifically for hunting, cattle grazing, camping, or educational programs, may be permissible in the future under proper regulations; however, the Theodore Roosevelt Association strongly recommends that to preserve the natural landscape, there be no further surface interruptions."

We have kept in close touch on conditions in North Dakota, and I think I can fairly say that our resolution of last October (which I'll mail to you) represents informed judgment.

In looking at the situation, it might be possible to cooperate in some way with the State of North Dakota on this land. Perhaps the land could be owned by the federal government and managed by the state park system, thereby saving the NPS some labor costs.
