### Talking Points on Gephardt Stimulus Proposal

<u>The plan does not meet its stated objectives</u>. Gephardt says "We need policies devoted to one central purpose: creating economic growth with more jobs and higher wages for Americans." "I am offering a five-point plan to restore economic growth, both in the short-run and in the long-term."

His proposals will at best provide modest short-run stimulus, but impair long-run growth.

The heart of the economic problem is a slow recovery in business investment. Gephardt's investment proposals are too modest to have substantial impact; the remainder of the plan impairs investment incentives.

Effect on the Economy and Budget. Gephardt's plan calls for \$125 billion in new spending and \$75 billion in one-time tax cuts for households and businesses.

Gephardt's plan calls for \$25 billion in investment school construction, \$25 billion in "protecting infrastructure from terrorism" and \$25 billion "to help with the health care crisis."

 States have capital budgets intended to insulate their school spending, infrastructure construction, and other long-lived projects from recessions. Any new spending induced by the Gephardt plan will be <u>additional</u> spending on top of normal plans – and likely to create demand for additional federal funds in the future.

\$25 billion of additional terrorism spending is targeted for "local police, fire fighters, public health workers..." This is <u>not</u> stimulus, it is building bigger government payrolls that are unlikely to be cut back in the future.

 \$75 billion to "help with the health care crisis" is intended for "hiring of nurses, doctors, and other health care providers..." In short, this is a public-sector jobs program.

The total will <u>not</u> constitute short-run stimulus and it will not be temporary. If the new demands created are perpetuated, the \$1.25 trillion over the next ten years will work to damage the long-run growth potential of the economy – at odds with its stated proposal.

A \$1.25 trillion increase in spending will create a demand for additional taxes. A tax increase of this magnitude will reduce GDP growth by nearly 0.2 percentage points every year – an impact that CBO projections would translate to \$24 billion in 2010, but rise to \$350 billion in 2020.

- Princeton University economist Harvey Rosen has estimated that the tax rate reductions passed in 2001 will lower the "deadweight loss" or pure drag on the economy by roughly \$40 billion in 2010. Taxes raised to cover Gephardt's spending increases would forfeit this gain. To put this figure in perspective, note that it is about the same size as last year's tax rebate of \$36 billion and it would happen every year.
- Gephardt proposes \$125 in new spending, but identifies at best \$100 billion in unspecified "corporate welfare" at odds with the notion that this proposal controls the size of government.
- The prospect of higher taxes in the future will reduce incentives to save and invest.
- These proposals are at odds with fiscal discipline. In the end, fiscal discipline requires controls on spending. Uncontrolled spending must ultimately be paid for with higher taxes.
- Temporary tax cuts don't stimulate investment.
  - One-year tax cuts for investment are inadequate for the task and will not stimulate investment. They provide no bang for the buck.
  - The President's stimulus plan called for and enacted into law 3-year partial expensing of investment.
    - Three years matches the planning, budgeting, and replacement cycle for equipment and software the critical part of an investment recovery.
    - Partial expensing works just like an investment tax credit.

A one-time temporary tax cut or rebate for consumers will have little impact.

- When times are tough, families hang on to their money. One-time rebates will most likely be saved.
- The President's checks stimulated the economy because they were <u>not</u> a one-time affair. The 10 percent bracket is permanent so the "check" comes <u>every</u> year. Real stimulus is permanent tax cuts.
- Increases in the minimum wage and extensions of unemployment insurance will increase the unemployment race.
  - Increases in the unemployment insurance will cause the unemployment rate to remain 0.2 to 0.3 percentage points higher than necessary.

• Raising the minimum wage to \$6.65 will have several effects, many of which are detrimental to low-income workers.

More than half of minimum wage workers are under age 25, and only 34 percent are husbands, wives, or women or men maintaining families. The minimum wage does not target lowincome workers and families effectively – only 1/3 of workers affected by the 1990 increase were at or near the poverty line.

The minimum wage hurts employment. Evidence suggests that the number of families pulled above the poverty line by increases in the minimum wage would be no larger than the number pushed below by increased unemployment.

- Gephardt is behind the curve.
  - The Administration has proposals to remove the tax-based incentives to move overseas.
  - The President has proposed initiatives to make workers' pensions secure.

It has been widely reported that state governments have been subject to increasing fiscal distress due to a sharp down turn in revenues. For the first quarter of 2002, total state tax revenue was down 7.9 percent from a year earlier. The second quarter year-over-year decline is even larger – 10.9 percent.

The National Conference of State Legislators' estimates that in FY 2003, 14 states will have a budget gap, a measure of state fiscal distress, of 10 percent or more as a percent of their general fund budget. All states, however, are not facing severe distress – in FY 2003, 8 states are estimated to have no budget gap and another 5 states are estimated to have a budget gap of less than 1 percent.

States that anticipated the transitory nature of the revenue surge of the late 1990s, and put aside revenue in so-called "rainy day" funds, appear to be in a much better position, in contrast to states with substantial spending increases and tax cuts in recent years.

An analysis of current state revenue gap and state spending and revenue patterns during the last decade reveals that the states facing the greatest distress are those states that allowed spending growth to rise and revenue growth to fall during the late 1990s relative to their historical growth. In contrast, states that maintained spending and revenue growth at levels more consistent with their historical growth appear not to be facing severe fiscal distress.

#### State Budget Gap

The figure below considers whether the state budget gap (as a percent of the general fund) is, on average, higher for states with higher spending growth and lower revenue growth during 1997 through 2000, the period of the surge in state revenue, relative to their historical spending and revenue growth. The average state budget gap is a measure of state fiscal distress reported by the National Conference of State Legislators.

States are divided into two groups depending on whether they had high or low expenditure growth from 1997-2000 relative to their expenditure growth for the entire decade. The same grouping is done based on revenues, and the average state budget gap is reported for each combination on the chart shown below.

The pattern that emerges is that states with low revenue growth and high spending growth in the late 1990s, relative to their historical growth, are more likely to experience distress than states that kept spending and revenue growth in line with historical norms. In FY 2002, states with high spending growth and low revenue growth faced an average 11.6 percent budget gap. In contrast, low-spending states with high revenue growth faced only a 5.3 percent budget gap in FY 2002. A similar relationship is found for the 2003 budget gap and is confirmed in a more detailed statistical analysis.

"The decision by the Administration not to release the Medicare physician payment rule today in order to ensure accuracy is a good one. Errors in past calculations gave us the unintended Medicare payment cuts we're fighting now. Another round of Medicare payment cuts based on flawed data will have devastating consequences for America's seniors. "Congress must pass legislation early in the lame-duck session to avert a crisis in access for Medicare patients. Congress, the Administration and AARP all recognize that the issue of proper payment for physicians is unique and urgent. Government mistakes in calculating the Medicare payment formula led to a 5.4% cut in Medicare physician payments in 2002, and unless Congress acts Medicare officials have projected an additional 12% reduction over the next three years, totaling \$11 billion.

"If Congress doesn't act, Medicare payments in 2005 will be back below the 1991 level, while physician practice costs are expected to rise by 40 percent during that period.

"Surveys by patient and physician groups show that previous payment cuts have led to growing access problems for Medicare patients. Medicare beneficiaries are already having trouble finding physicians to treat them in more than half the states surveyed, according to a survey by the Medicare Rights Center. An AMA survey found that 24 percent of physicians have either placed limits on the number of Medicare patients they treat or plan to institute limits soon.

"It is critical that Medicare officials get it right. Many private insurers and other public programs base their payments on the Medicare fee schedule. Military organizations have expressed concerns that Medicare payment cuts are causing serious access problems for retirees and active duty dependents enrolled in the Tricare program. "Physician practices have reached their brocking point. Physician

"Physician practices have reached their breaking point. Physicians want to serve America's seniors, but they simply cannot afford to accept an

unlimited number of Medicare patients into their practices, while facing continued payment cuts.

"Medicare's foundation is crumbling, and the American Medical Association is making an all-out lobbying and grassroots effort to stop the destruction. We have urged physicians to make "house calls" on their lawmakers in their home states before the election and in Washington when Congress returns for the lame-duck session. Congress must stop these drastic cuts that will devastate the Medicare program."

The last time Democrats failed to pick-up House seats against a first-term GOP president was 1878 when Rutherford B. Hayes was in the White House; independents took 6 seats from Democrats and 9 nine seats from Republicans that year.

The ONLY time Republicans gained House seats with a first term president was in 1902, and that was only because the size of Congress expanded 29 seats (from 356 to 385); Republicans gained 9 seats, but Democrats gained 25 seats that year.

This advisory is based on the scheduled itinerary as of this date, and reflects the additional trip site, St. Petersburg, Russia. All previous medical information remains valid. Additionally, due to the risk of water contamination with heavy metals and the water-borne parasite, Giardia, drink only bottled water in St. Petersburg. Travelers deviating from the official itinerary should contact the White House Medical Unit (757-2476) for further medical travel advice.

#### Immunizations

Summary of Recommended Vaccines

- Routine/childhood vaccines
   Hepatitis A
- Polio Booster
   Typhoid
- Influenza 2002-2003 "flu shot"

<u>Detailed Vaccination Information</u>: All travelers should ensure that their routine childhood immunizations (tetanus, diphtheria, polio, measles, and varicella [chicken pox]) are up-to-date. A one-time booster dose of polio vaccine is recommended for travelers who have previously completed the standard course of polio immunization (this booster does not need to be repeated for subsequent travel). The Medical Unit also recommends that all travelers obtain hepatitis A and typhoid vaccinations. Hepatitis A is a viral infection of the liver that is usually transmitted by unclean food handling; the vaccine is a two-shot series, good for ten years. Typhoid is a bacterial infection also transmitted by unclean food handling; the injected vaccine is good for two years (an oral vaccine, which may be available through your personal physician, is good for five years).

Immunizations achieve optimal benefit when administered as soon as possible prior to travel (optimally at least 10 to 14 days ahead). The recommended vaccinations are offered to traveling passholders at the White House Medical Office in Room 105 of the DDEEOB (757-2476). Immunization hours are 9:00 to 11:00 AM and 1:00 to 3:30 PM Monday through Friday (the

office is closed on weekends and holidays). Good medical practice and safety requires that you be monitored in the Medical Office for 15 minutes after receiving any injection. Vaccines also may be obtained through your personal physician or the U.S. State Department Travel Clinic at 663-1705 (copies of your official orders are required for the State Department Clinic).

The 2002-2003 influenza vaccine is available at the White House Medical Office and it is <u>highly</u> recommended for this trip.

#### **Dietary Precautions**

Although food from established restaurants is generally safe, we suggest caution in eating undercooked fish, shellfish, raw vegetables and salads from other than deluxe establishments. Tap water is safe in Prague. At all other locations we recommend bottled, or boiled and filtered, water only. As noted, the water in St. Petersburg has a high concentration of Giardia. Please contact a Medical Unit staff member if you experience gastrointestinal symptoms (e.g., bloating, diarrhea, or vomiting) that you believe are associated with travel.

European authorities have taken great pains to protect their herds from spongiform encephalitis ("mad cow disease"), but many physicians still recommend avoiding ground beef products or organ meats. While beef is considered relatively safe in Western Europe due to these extensive precautions, public health systems in Eastern Europe are not as well developed. Exercise caution in your meat selection.

#### Additional Issues (Items with " \*" are additions to the standard travel precautions)

- ★ Eastern European countries have had increased rates of tick-borne diseases (such as Lyme disease, tularemia, and encephalitis). Travelers should avoid wooded areas (including urban parks) as much as possible. Insect repellents which include "DEET" can be useful, but they are not as effective against ticks as against mosquitoes. Avoidance of high risk (i.e., wooded) areas is the most effective prevention.
- ★ Fish tapeworm (cestode) infection is present in Lithuania. We advise strict avoidance of undercooked fish and roe.
- ★ Rabies is highly prevalent in Romania. Avoidance of dogs and all wild animals is advised. If bitten or scratched, promptly cleanse with soap and hot water and seek medical evaluation and treatment without delay.
- ★ The peak "flu" season is November to March. The 2002-2003 influenza vaccine is highly recommended for all travelers. The "flu" is usually common in these countries in November, and unvaccinated travelers are more susceptible when their immune system is "stressed" by work, travel, dietary changes, and sleep disruptions.

- Jet lag is "moderate" when traveling to central and eastern Europe, and may take several days to overcome. Jet lag is best overcome by adapting to destination sleep/wake and meal patterns as quickly as possible. Stay well-hydrated and exercise regularly. Early morning exposure to daylight will help reset your body clock. Late afternoon sunlight is beneficial on return. Sleeping pills will aid in initiating sleep, but will not reset your internal clock. Sleeping pills are prescription medications with potential side effects and drug interactions; please address the use of such medications with your physician prior to departure.
- HIV, Hepatitis B, and other sexually transmitted diseases are prevalent in most urban areas around the world. Prague and Bucharest have populations with unusually high reported incidences of HIV.
- Blood supply safety varies by country. Blood or blood products should be avoided. Be careful. Motor vehicle accidents are the number one "medical threat" to your health.
- Bring additional contact lens solutions, glasses, personal prescription medications, over-thecounter cold and allergy remedies, and pain/headache relief preparations.
- People who are prone to asthma or respiratory conditions should take extra precautions. People with known asthma should ensure they have an adequate supply of their medication.
- Tuberculosis is common in all developing countries. Romania has a prevalence of over 100 cases per 100,000 people, the highest World Health Organization (WHO) category. Annual skin testing (PPD) for possible TB exposure is highly recommended.

Additional travel medicine information or assistance with individual concerns is available from the White House Medical Office at 202-757-2476, or the Centers for Disease Control website, <u>www.cdc.gov/travel</u>. Please do not hesitate to contact the White House Medical Unit for further questions or assistance.

A medical unit representative will be at each site, and will have coordinated a medical care plan with each embassy. If you require any care during the trip or have specific individual concerns, please make our representative or the embassy medical officer your first call. Please note that if local (non-US government) medical services are required, most providers and facilities will require immediate (or possibly advance) payment by cash or credit card. US insurance will not be accepted, although in many cases, you can file for reimbursement on return to the US (contact your insurance carrier for specific details on your insurance company's policies).

#### Considerations on the Status of the American Society

The Siciliano Lecture is the cornerstone of the annual Rocco C. Siciliano Forum. The lecture defines and shapes the issues and debates for other Siciliano Forum events that will surround and support your lecture. These will include a dinner to honor you as the Siciliano Lecturer, special courses offered in the Department of Political Science, and panels and colloquia at the Hinckley Institute of Politics.
