**Scope and Content Note:** White House Press Office, Press Releases series consists of press releases containing schedules, reports, correspondence, proclamations, fact sheets and executive orders. These materials consist of statements by the Press Secretary and President George W. Bush, the President and Mrs. Bush's weekly and daily press schedules, announcements of appointments to various positions within the Administration, nominations to various judgeships and biographies of appointees and nominees to various positions within the George W. Bush Administration. Also present are reports including the "Report of the Department of the Treasury on Employer Stock in 401 (k) Plans" and a "Report in Connection with Presidential Determination Under Public Law 107-243", correspondence to cabinet officials and Congress regarding various topics including foreign trade, drug control, the Global War on Terrorism and

proclamations regarding Greek Independence Day, National Poison Prevention Week, Women's History Month and the National Bone and Joint Decade. Fact sheets in these materials cover a range of topics from affordable health care and opening new markets for America's small businesses to No Child Left Behind and implementing the Syria Accountability and Lebanese Sovereignty Act of 2003. In addition, there are Executive Orders amending the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2003 and establishing the Great Lakes Interagency Task Force, the President's Board on Safeguarding America's Civil Liberties and the National Counterterrorism Center.

This collection is fully processed. The White House Press Office ceased filing hard copies of press releases in 2006. From there forward all press releases were filed electronically.
