Thank you for providing me with the cases, Brett. I have been reading them. I am on my way back to Washington after participating in a conference on the future of presidential libraries held at the Johnson Library.

What I have tried to do for the meeting is get together people who represent organizations with a special interest in presidential records. I am a presidency scholar and serve as the representative to the National Archives for the American Political Science Association.
