FOIA 2020-0187-F requested materials related to correspondence between President George W. Bush and Anthony S. Fauci.

This FOIA primarily contains barcode scanning sheets, printed and signed photographs of President George W. Bush with event participants, tracking sheets, printed administrative emails, photo submission sheets, event briefing papers, sticky notes and labels, White House staffing memoranda, and an information memorandum for the President from Anthony S. Fauci entitled Resistant Strain of Human Immunodeficiency Virus and drafts thereof. Events include the presentation of the 2005 and 2006 National Medals of Science and Technology and the 2008

Presidential Medal of Freedom Ceremony.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2020-0187-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence.
