This FOIA primarily contains draft letters thanking airport greeters and individuals who assisted President George W. Bush during his trip to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee in August 2002 including Donald Melkus, a list of airport greeters, and corresponding Presidential Event Participation Forms for the "Wisconsin Welcomes President Bush" event.

System of Arrangement
