FOIA 2024-0073-F requested materials related to a letter sent in January 2003 by 46 religious leaders about the proposed war on Iraq.

This FOIA primarily contains a letter and printouts from a website about the proposed invasion of Iraq from the World Citizen Foundation and printouts from that organization's website.
