### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0201-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-0201-F requested materials related to Jamaat ul-Fuqra, also named Jamaat Al-Fuqra, Tanzeem ul Fuqra, or International Quranic Open University.

This FOIA primarily contains State Department press guidance; open source information and reports; homeland security briefs; draft Future Years Homeland Security Program reports; A Military Guide to Terrorism in the Twenty-First Century Handbook; a Terrorist Groups Thesaurus; a draft Office of Science and Technology Policy prospectus on social, behavioral, and economic sciences; a draft Coast Guard Report on 2006 Resources to Address Key Issues in Port Security; and agency FOIA logs.

Please note that a portion of classified records related to this request has not yet been processed. Additional records will be provided as they become available.

# **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0201-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.

The following is a list of electronic search results lists (SRLs) processed in response to FOIA 2016-0201-F:

## George W. Bush Electronic Records

ARMS contains 263 assets, of which 15 are released in full, 244 are withheld in part, and 4 are withheld in full.

Exchange contains 259 assets, of which 129 are released in full, 111 are withheld in part, and 19 are withheld in full.

Exchange - 40 Days contains 5 assets, all of which are released in full.

NSC contains 4 assets, all of which are withheld in part.

RNC contains 7 assets, of which 0 are released in full, 2 are withheld in part, and 5 are withheld in full.

WHO contains 10 assets, of which 6 are released in full, 3 are withheld in part, and 1 is withheld in full.
