Scope and Content

FOIA 2018-0064-F requested textual materials from the Office of Laura Bush related to education initiatives such as improving literacy and character and community initiatives.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence, schedules, printed material, and printed emails.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2018-0064-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection area – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
