Scope and Content

FOIA 2025-0046-F requested materials related to WHTV footage of Georgian President Shevardnadze's October 5, 2001, Oval Office Meeting with President George W. Bush.

This FOIA primarily contains four video clips from tape WHTV 645 10/04/2001 Photo-Op Tape 2 for 1-7 Oct 2001 including a joint statement with President Vicente Fox of Mexico on October 4, 2001 in the White House Rose Garden, an Oval Office meeting with Sheikh Hamad bin Khalifa Al Thani, Amir of Qatar, on October 4, 2001, an Oval Office meeting with President Eduard Shevardnadze of Georgia on October 5, 2001, and a departure from the South Lawn via Marine One on October 5, 2001.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2025-0046-F are a systematic body of records responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
